This is a juried event and the Tuolumne County Chamber of Commerce reserves the right to decide which applications to accept. By submitting this application, you acknowledge reading the guidelines and agree to abide said guidelines.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

The deadline for vendor applications is Friday, September 13, 2019.

Autumn Artisan Festival is open to all fine crafters and artists. Manufactured goods, imported items or resale items will not be accepted at this event. The application review process begins when you submit your completed application with ALL required attachments. Not submitting the requested items could result in immediate denial of your application. Upon completion of the review process you will be notified whether your application has been approved or denied. For applications not accepted, your full payment will be returned.

To enter, exhibitors must submit a completed application, the booth fee, at least 2 photographs of current work or website link where products can be viewed.

VENDOR FEES:

CRAFTS/ARTISAN - \$65.00 per 10' x 10' space for chamber members | \$75.00 per 10' x 10' space for non-members

FOOD VENDOR FEES - \$150.00 per 10' x 10' space for chamber members plus 10% of profits.

TENTS:

The festival is an outdoor event and is held rain or shine. All vendors are required to have a tent. All spaces are 10'x10'. All vendors must provide their own tent(s), tables, etc. If your tent is larger than 10'x10' you must rent two spaces.

VENDOR PLACEMENT:

Booth placement is at the discretion of the festival organizers. While you may request a specific location, it CANNOT be guaranteed.

FOOD & BEVERAGES:

Food and Beverage Vendors have exclusive rights to sell these items. Food and beverages may not be sold or distributed by arts and crafts vendors.

VEHICLE ACCESS:

Vendors attending Autumn Artisan Festival have designated parking. If you have special needs please note that on your application. Further information is noted on the following pages.

PAYMENT:

Please enclose a check or money order payable to the Tuolumne County Chamber of Commerce with your completed application.

VENDOR SET-UP:

Set-up will begin from 7:30am and must be completed by 10:30am. Vendors should unload vehicles then move vehicles to the designated vendor parking area. Do not begin set up until your vehicle has been moved.
